



SETTING UP YOUR OPS-A

Learn how to setup your OPS-A module, first time it is plugged in and powered on.

1



Turn on ActivPanel LX, select the **OPS** source and wait for the OPS-A module to boot.


Select **Language** from the dropdown-menu og then **start**.

3




Select your **Wi-Fi** network from the **list**, enter **password** and press **Connect**.
If using a wired (LAN) network, skip this step.

When prompted whether to **copy apps & data**, select **don't copy** (recommended).



If you wish to connect to a **Google Account**, you can do so in this step.

NB: Using a personal Google Account is not recommended.


Enable or disable your preferred **Google Services** as desired, and click **Accept**.


Learn how to setup your OPS-A module, first time it is plugged in and powered on.


If you wish to select a **pin lock** for your OPS-A, you may set it in this step. Select **Next**, re-type your **pin code** and then **Confirm**.
