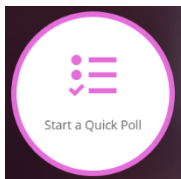


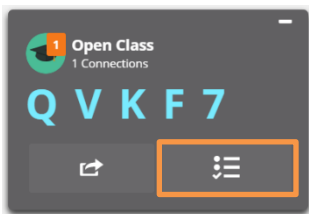
How to Use ClassFlow Polling

ClassFlow polling is an engaging and easy way to check students' comprehension, gather opinions, ideas, or suggestions, focus attention, and gather formative data.

Note: You must have at least one student connected to initiate a poll.



To poll from the ClassFlow homepage, select the **Start a Quick Poll** button to reveal the Connection Panel. Choose from eight poll types. Once you start a poll, an Instant Whiteboard will open and student responses will populate in real time.



To poll from a ClassFlow lesson, select the **Poll** button on your Teacher Panel. Choose from eight poll types to gather formative data. Once you start a poll, the currently selected teacher or student card is sent to all connected students.

Regardless of how you start a poll, once it is underway, your Teacher Panel displays **Pause** and **Stop** buttons. You may pause or stop the poll at any time.

Poll results populate anonymously by default. Toggle **Show Names** to reveal students' names.



Student responses display on a new card. This results card will appear in your card carousel with a pink bar graph icon. You may reposition responses, color code them, connect responses, delete them, and even begin a new poll from any response. Add a teacher response by double clicking in the gray area of the results card.

ClassFlow automatically saves all poll results under the **Classes** tab for easy access.

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
